

Controlling Lifting Operations – Crane Supervisor

This SVQ is a mandatory requirement for any CPCS red cardholder and who has undertaken the A62 CPCS Technical Test. By achieving this SVQ the red cardholder will be eligible to apply for the CPCS blue competency card which is then valid for 5 years.

Costs are per candidate:

- Controlling Lifting Operations (Supervision) - Crane Supervisor £850 + VAT
There is an additional SQA registration fee of £65.00 per candidate.
- This registration fee is paid on your behalf to SQA and is non refundable.
Mileage for site visit will be charged at 50ppm

The fee includes:

- Registration with SQA for this qualification
- All associated administration work in achieving the qualification including portfolio and copies of the relevant standards
- Induction of the candidate either as a individual or as part of a group
- Access to a named SVQ Assessor for ongoing Information, Advice and Guidance plus assessment
- Two assessment visit per qualification two visit is normally sufficient)
- Portfolio building – a collection of work based evidence which proves competence
- Submission of portfolio for assessment and verification
- Internal Verification prior to competency claim (quality assurance)
- Formal claim and certification issued by Scottish Qualification Authority (SQA)

Candidate's involvement

The candidate will be asked to keep copies of all work based evidence which will support his/her claim to competence. This can include any Photographs, hire sheets, method statements, risk assessments, records of toolbox talks etc that the candidate has been involved. Only his/her own work can be used. Each company operates differently so there may be other evidence that can be produced. The candidate's named assessor will provide all the support they need to ensure that they achieve the qualification quickly and efficiently.

Invoicing

Invoices will be sent after Registration into the Scheme and a Navigator Report will be issued of Proof.
