#### COURSE DETAILS

Title: Slinger/Signaller Note: mobile cranes require an additional day

Duration: Three consecutive days including 1 day Technical Test including Theory and Practical

Candidate Numbers: 3 Candidates

#### TARGET DELEGATES

This course is aimed at inexperienced operatives who are required to undertake slinging and signaling for the movement of loads using lifting equipment. Candidates may be new to the role or may be those with limited experience and no formal training

#### COURSE AIM AND CONTENTS

The aim of this course is to provide candidates with practical and theoretical knowledge in order for them to undertake the role of the Slinger/Signaller. Following successful completion of the course candidates will be able to select the correct lifting accessories, attach them to loads safely and guide the load using the appropriate hand signals. Topics covered during this course include::

- Legislation: LOLER, PUWER, HASAWA.
- Codes of practice - BS7121.
- Roles and responsibilities of personnel involved with lifting operations.
- Crane appreciation crane types, capabilities and limitations.
- Lifting accessories
- Documentation and certification for lifting accessories.
- Sling Angles.
- Slinging techniques.
- Down rating of accessories.
- Communications.
- Establishing load weight and centre of gravity
- Proximity hazards
- Selecting lifting accessories.
- Attaching accessories to different loads
- Signalling for the lifting, transferring and positioning of loads
- Safe use of radios
